

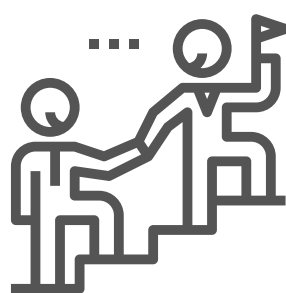
Pathway to Become a Lawyer
